Vertical Selection is done by treating a vertical as a single resource with its constituent engines combined, and then selecting verticals using the ReDDE resource selection algorithm as implemented in the LiDR toolkit by Ilya Markov. An additional truncating step is employed to stop selecting a vertical when the discounted gain of selecting that vertical is below certain threshold. |
