Description	Index: Central Sample Index overall all the sampled docs using Indri 5.5 (Krovtz stemmer, not removing stopwords). Retrieval: plain query terms with BM25 retrieval model (k=1.2, b=0.75). Vertical Selection is done by treating a vertical as a single resource with its constituent engines combined, and then selecting verticals using the CRCSLinear resource selection algorithm as implemented in the LiDR toolkit by Ilya Markov. An additional truncating step is employed to stop selecting a vertical when the discounted gain of selecting that vertical is below certain threshold.
