Qualitative judgments	
Q1: Does the summary include names of the main people (hosts, guests, characters) involved or mentioned in the podcast?	54.9%
Q2: Does the summary give any additional information about the people mentioned (such as their job titles, biographies, personal background, etc)?	32.6%
Q3: Does the summary include the main topic(s) of the podcast?	60.6%
Q4: Does the summary tell you anything about the format of the podcast; e.g. whether it's an interview, whether it's a chat between friends, a monologue, etc?	42.0%
Q5: Does the summary give you more context on the title of the podcast?	52.8%
Q6: Does the summary contain redundant information?	45.1%
Q7: Is the summary written in good English?	45.6%
Q8: Are the start and end of the summary good sentence and paragraph start and end points?	18.1%
Q9: Does the audio clip give a sense of what the podcast sounds like?	89.1%
